THIS WEEK IN HISTORY

13-Aug-1961 The German Democratic Republic closes the border between the eastern and western sectors of Berlin, to thwart its inhabitants' attempts to escape to the West. The barrier included guard towers placed along large concrete walls, which circumscribed a wide area (later known as the "death strip") that contained anti-vehicle trenches, "fakir beds" & other defences. The fall of the Berlin Wall paved the way for German reunification, which was formally concluded October 3, 1990.

14-Aug-1880 Construction of Cologne Cathedral, the most famous landmark in Cologne, Germany, is completed. Construction began in 1248. Cologne Cathedral is a Roman Catholic church and is the seat of the Archbishop of Cologne. It is renowned as a monument of Christianity, of Gothic architecture and of the continuing faith and perseverance of the people of the city in which it stands. It is visited by 30 thousand people every day.

15-Aug-1969 The Woodstock Music and Art Festival opens. During the sometimes rainy weekend, 32 acts performed outdoors in front of 500,000 concert-goers. It is widely regarded as one of the greatest and most pivotal moments in popular music history and was listed among *Rolling Stone's 50 Moments That Changed the History of Rock and Roll*.

16-Aug-1896 Skookum Jim Mason, George Carmack and Dawson Charlie discover gold in a tributary of the Klondike River in Canada, setting off the Klondike Gold Rush. Men from all walks of life headed for the Yukon from as far away as New York, South Africa, the UK & Australia. In 1898, the population in the Klondike may have reached 40,000. In total, about 12.5 million ounces of gold (about 390 tones) have been taken from the Klondike area in the century since its discovery.

17-Aug-1999 A 7.4-magnitude earthquake strikes Izmit, Turkey. The event lasted for 37 seconds. An official Turkish estimate of October 19, 1999, placed the toll at 17,127 killed and 43,959 injured, but many sources suggest the actual figure may have been closer to 45,000 dead and a similar number injured. The earthquake caused a tsunami in the Sea of Marmara that was about 3 meters high.

18-Aug-1977 Steve Biko is arrested at a police roadblock under the Terrorism Act No 83 of 1967 in King William's Town, South Africa. He would later die of the injuries sustained during this arrest bringing attention to South Africa's apartheid policies. Biko was a noted anti-apartheid activist in South Africa in the 1960s & 70's. A student leader, he later founded the Black Consciousness Movement which would empower and mobilize much of the urban black population. Since his death in police custody, he has been called a martyr of the anti-apartheid movement. While living, his writings and activism attempted to empower black people, and he was famous for his slogan "black is beautiful".

19-Aug-1960 Sputnik program: Sputnik 5 – the Soviet Union launches the satellite with the dogs Belka and Strelka, 40 mice, 2 rats and a variety of plants. It paved the way for the first human orbital flight less than eight months later with Vostok 1. Shortly after the landing, one of Strelka's puppies was sent to Jacqueline Kennedy as a present from the Soviet Union.
